



Technology Integrated Novel Studies

Below are some ideas in which you could use technology for whole groups studying a novel.

Students could divide the novel into sections and set reading goals. Once the goal has been met and the student has read the section, they could complete a **Response Journal** entry in a database such as FileMaker Pro.

Students could create a web of character traits and compare characters using a graphic organizer program such as Smart Ideas.

Using a graphic organizer program such as Smart Ideas, students could outline events that led to the conflict in the novel and/or create a plot diagram. Students could also use a this type of program to classify events in the novel that revealed various themes.

Place students in groups and ask them to choose an event from the novel. Students work collaboratively create 8 ½" x 14" comic strip frames based on the event chosen. Each frame is scanned and imported into Corel Draw to create a comic strip that illustrates a key event from the novel.

Students could conduct a review of a website related to the novel using the **Website Review** database created in FileMaker Pro.
