## Smart Board

A Smart Board is an interactive white board. It is a touch-sensitive display that connects to a computer and digital projector to show a computer image. The computer image can then be controlled directly from the display and notes can be written in digital ink and saved to share later. It is an important teaching tool and the students love to use it. The SAC has purchased a Smart Board that will be dedicated for use in the library. All classes use the library on a weekly basis and they can have the opportunity to use the Smart Board during this time. The Smart Board can also be used in the computer lab when needed.
